Final Settlement

In respect of final settlement, the Floating Price will be a price in USD and cents per barrel based on the difference between the average of the “Mid” quotations appearing in the “Platts Crude Oil Marketwire” under the heading “Key benchmarks (\$/barrel)” for “Brent (Dated)” and the average of the “Mid” quotations appearing in the “Platts Crude Oil Marketwire” under the heading “Forward Dated Brent (\$/barrel)” for “Mediterranean Dated strip” for each business day (as specified below) in the determination period.
