In recognition of the passing of President Jimmy Carter, the Exchange will observe a moment of silence at 8:18 am NY time on Thursday, January 9, 2025.

Trading in each of the following futures contracts will end at 9:30 am NY time on that day:

- Micro NYSE FANG+™ Index futures contracts (contract symbol FNG)
- NYSE Biotechnology GTR Index futures contracts (contract symbol IUT)
- NYSE Semiconductor GTR Index futures contracts (contract symbol IUS)

Trading in each of the following futures contracts will end at 1:15 pm NY time on that day:

- ICE One-Month SOFR Index Futures (contract symbol SR1)
- ICE Three-Month SOFR Index Futures (contract symbol SR3)
- ICE Conforming 30-year Fixed Mortgage Rate Lock Weighted APR Index Futures (contract symbol 30C)
- ICE Jumbo 30-year Fixed Mortgage Rate Lock Weighted APR Index Futures (contract symbol 30J)

Settlement prices for these contracts will likely reflect prior day settlements, but in the event of a significant price move may instead be based on prices during the last minute of trading.
